

In 1969, a small group of pilot friends flew to the Bahamas to build a church for a congregation in need. The project sparked a revolution, and the basis for a short-term missions organization was born. 
As a non-profit organization, Maranatha relies on the support of volunteers and donors to fulfill our mission to provide urgently needed buildings around the world. Here are some ways you can help Maranatha.



Give Churches You can help to provide places of worship by donating for the construction of churches. Maranatha provides a variety of structures at a range of costs, depending on location. Make a gift or sponsor a church, starting at \$7,500.



Give Schools Education is a powerful tool for change in a community. It also introduces people to the Gospel. Maranatha builds classrooms, multi-classroom buildings, and entire campuses. Make a gift or call to learn how you can sponsor a building.



Give Water Maranatha's water program provides wells in areas without access to clean water. Currently, we are drilling in Kenya, India, and Brazil, where a single well can serve anywhere from 500-5,000 people. Make a gift for water or sponsor a well, starting at \$10,000.



Give Time People interested in service can volunteer with Maranatha in two ways. The first is by joining a project that Maranatha organizes in full. The second way is by recruiting your own team and having Maranatha help with the details. We'll locate a country site, assign a



project, help you with lodging and food, and share our in-country staff as a resource during the trip.
