ABOUT THE ONE-DAY CHURCH

The One-Day Church program strives to meet the worldwide need for church buildings with a high quality, low-cost, easy-to-build structure called the One-Day Church (ODC).

The ODC kit provides the roofing and framework, two components that are the most difficult and expensive to attain for most areas where we work. The local congregation finishes the walls and floors with local materials according to their custom.

In some countries, Maranatha provides the ODC kit and completes the walls. The degree of aid that Maranatha provides varies from country to country.
