MANPOWER

Maranatha crews in Zambia often work from sunrise to past sunset



Crewmembers spend 300 nights per year sleeping in tents or truckbeds

320 churches built



Takes an average of 4 hours for an experienced crew to put up a church

Crews drive anywhere from 2 hours to 2 days to arrive at each worksite



5 school campuses built

60% of Zambians live in rural areas; 40% live in urban centers



Poor households spend 75% or more of their household income on food.



Rural congregations must rebuild the roof or entire church structure every 1-2 years
