THE GIFT OF WATER

In response to the worldwide water crisis, Maranatha is providing wells in communities without access to clean water. The wells are usually located where Maranatha has constructed a church or school, and the water becomes a form of outreach to the community.

Each well becomes central to the community for decades to come. **It is one of the** *simplest, most impactful actions that can help transform lives from surviving to thriving*.

About the Water Well Program

The majority of Maranatha's water program has been focused in southern Africa. Since 2007, Maranatha has helped to drill more than 800 wells in this region. Currently, Maranatha is working in Zimbabwe, Zambia, and Kenya.

- Each well is drilled on or near the site of a church or school built by Maranatha, and the well becomes a point of outreach to the surrounding community.
- Special trucks called rigs house the equipment to bore deep into the earth through sand, dirt, limestone, granite, or just about any substance. The heavy trucks drive to the sites indicated by geologists to be the most likely spot to strike water, and drills to the recommended depths.
- If successful, a casing and hand pump is installed, along with a cement apron to prevent contamination.
