

# 2019 PROJECT LOCATIONS

## NORTH AMERICA

(U.S. and Canada)

Each year Maranatha coordinates multiple projects in North America. These are in response to requests for renovation or construction assistance from churches, schools, and other Seventh-day Adventist organizations. While Maranatha does not fundraise for these projects, we mobilize volunteers to provide labor.

## CUBA

Maranatha has been renovating and building churches in Cuba since the 1990s. Currently, crews have been assisting with the construction of a church in San Antonio de los Baños.

## SÃO TOMÉ & PRÍNCIPE

Maranatha plans to build four more churches on the island of São Tomé before closing out this project. This will bring the total number of church construction projects in the country to eight, along with eight classrooms constructed at the local Adventist school.

## KENYA

Last year, Maranatha constructed 85 One-Day Churches in Kenya and built classrooms at several school locations. This year, we are scheduled to build 100 One-Day Churches along with multiple school structures for existing campuses. Water well drilling will also continue throughout the country.

## INDIA

India continues to be a major focus for Maranatha. This year, we hope to build about 25 churches, complete a multi-classroom structure at Khunti Adventist School and begin another campus at Jingshai Mihngi Adventist School in Jowai. We also plan to drill water wells in India.

## COSTA RICA

We will be building two classrooms in Costa Rica.

## DOMINICA

Maranatha will wrap construction on the Beryl church, which was started in 2018, in March. Crews and volunteers will also build the community center at the Wesley church and erect two One-Day Churches with concrete floors. Both of these projects were started in response to 2017's Hurricane Maria, which devastated most of the structures on the island.

## PANAMA

Maranatha will build one church and paint a number of structures before wrapping up our effort in Panama.

## CÔTE D'IVOIRE

In 2019, Maranatha will begin working in Côte d'Ivoire by building churches and preparing for a school.

## ZAMBIA

Maranatha is returning to Zambia in 2019 in response to a request for more churches and school classrooms. The plan is to build 80 One-Day Churches this year and a school campus. The need for improved classroom space is critical.

## BOLIVIA

After building six churches and school classrooms last year, in 2019, Maranatha is slated to construct nine new churches in Cochabamba, Santa Clara, and La Paz.

## BRAZIL

Since 2011, Maranatha has constructed nearly 1,000 churches in Brazil. This year, we will complete construction on one church and research the possibility of drilling water wells.
