

# 2020 PROJECT LOCATIONS

## NORTH AMERICA (U.S. and Canada)

Each year Maranatha coordinates multiple projects in North America. These are in response to requests for renovation or construction assistance from churches, schools, and other Seventh-day Adventist organizations. While Maranatha does not fundraise for these projects, we mobilize volunteers to provide labor.

## CUBA

Crews are painting the San Antonio de los Baños Seventh-day Adventist Church.

## KENYA

There are a few major campuses that will be a priority for Maranatha, including Kajiado Adventist School and Rescue Center and Kiutine Adventist School. We'll also continue building One-Day Churches in the rural parts of the country and drilling water wells where needed most.

## INDIA

India continues to be a major focus for Maranatha, and we'll continue building churches and schools where needed. We're also providing water wells in communities that have no source of clean water.

## CÔTE D'IVOIRE

Maranatha is constructing churches and schools in the greater Abidjan area.

## PERU

After a successful effort about 15 years ago, Maranatha has returned to Peru to construct churches and schools.

## BOLIVIA

Maranatha crews are finishing a school and church that was delayed, due to political unrest, during last year's effort.

## BRAZIL

In 2020, Maranatha is concentrating on drilling water wells in the drier, northeast region of Brazil where rainfall is scarce.

## ZAMBIA

After a break, Maranatha returned to Zambia in 2019 in response to a request for more churches and school classrooms. This year, we'll continue this effort by building One-Day Churches, classrooms and wells.
