#### **Pre-Video Discussion Questions**

- Right now, there isn't a lot of traveling going on because of the coronavirus, but let's
  imagine you can go anywhere in the world. Which country would you like to visit the most,
  and why?
- You may not have been to your church for the past couple of Sabbaths. Do you remember
  what it looks like? Describe the materials used, how tall it is, what the floor is covered with,
  the type of seat or pew you sit in, etc.

## **Post-Video Discussion Questions**

- What types of things does Maranatha build?
- How does your church look different from some of the places people were worshipping at the beginning of the video?
- When Maranatha volunteers serve people, how do you think these people feel?
- How do you think Maranatha volunteers feel while serving people on a mission trip?
