If you've been watching Maranatha Kids! over the past few months, you may remember the story of Maleton, a Maasai girl in Kenya who escaped child marriage. Maleton was brought to the Kajiado Adventist School and Rescue Center, which became her new home.

The school's facilities were inadequate, so over the past couple of years, Maranatha has been constructing new dorms, bathrooms, and classrooms. One of the other great needs was water. There was a well on campus but it was broken, and purchasing water was too expensive.

Maranatha commissioned a geology report of the school's property, but it projected only a slight chance of water being found. The decision was made to try anyway, and the next day something miraculous happened.

As your kids watch this story, we hope they will reflect on how others live without water and the power that comes with prayer.
