save a substantial amount of money by providing expert advice on construction and supervised volunteer labor.

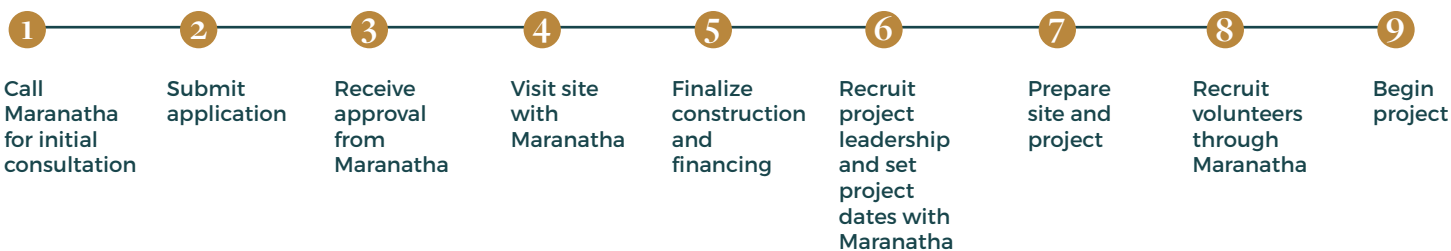
Maranatha even has a standard church design for small congregations in need of an affordable church. The architectural

plans include a sanctuary for 150-200 people, a fellowship hall, Sabbath School classrooms, bathrooms, audio-visual room, and an office.

There is no charge for our assistance, but host organizations are asked to provide meals, simple lodging, and basic insurance for our volunteers.
